As you know, this term Year 6 are studying the Ancient Greeks. In order to help their understanding of this topic, we have arranged for the children to have a Greek Day at school on **Monday 13th November**. The day will consist of many different activities.

As well as our Greek Day, the children will be making Moussaka later on in the week in order to try some traditional Greek food.

Also this term, Year 6 will be designing and making their very own pair of slippers as part of DT (they do not have to be Greek themed!) which they will be able to bring home and wear as they will be made to measure!

Of course, all of these extra activities and experiences are unfortunately not without cost.
