

Dear Parents/Carers,

This term our topic is Egyptians and we have been working hard in class finding out lots about how the Ancient Egyptians lived and the things that they did. In order to support our learning, we have organised a visit to the British Museum in London on **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2017**. As part of this trip, we will be lucky enough to experience exhibitions of genuine Egyptian artefacts. We are very lucky to have the opportunity to take the children to see this exhibition as it is the best Ancient Egyptian Exhibition in the UK. During the trip we will also be taking part in a spotlight talk about the Ancient Egyptian daily lives. We will be travelling by coach and need to leave school promptly at 8.20am. Therefore please ensure your child is in school for **8.15am** prompt so that we arrive at the museum in plenty of time for our talk. We are aiming to leave the museum at 2.15pm and will be returning to school by **4pm** (traffic dependent).

We have also organised an Egyptian Theatre Workshop in school on the **21<sup>st</sup> November 2017**. The children will have the chance to carry out role plays and get a better understanding of what life would have been like as an Ancient Egyptian. To get the children really thinking about this time period, as part of the experience we will be dressing up like Egyptians, so it would be great if the children could dress as an Egyptian for the day!

The full cost of this exciting trip and the other wonderful activities is £17.00 to cover the travel costs, entry to the schools area in the museum and a contribution towards the theatre workshop. However, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.00 towards this cost. Although this is a voluntary contribution we hope you will appreciate that for the trip to go ahead, we do rely on voluntary contributions being made for all children and that without them, the visit might have to be cancelled.
