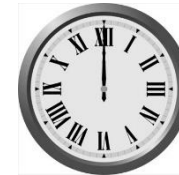




# TIKTOK ON THE CLOCK

Here are some fun activities related to our learning, that you can have a go at during your time at home.

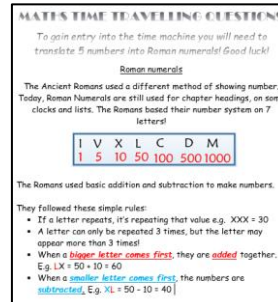
Don't forget to check **Mymaths** for your weekly maths tasks and **Seesaw** for extra learning tasks!
