Dear Parents and Carers,

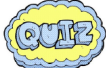

4pm - 5:30pm

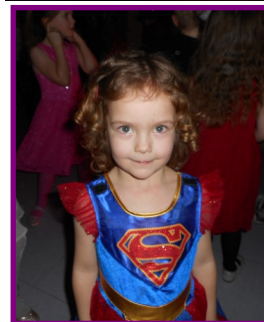
