#### Things you could use:

String

**Paperclips** 

Straws


Card/cardboard boxes

#### Essentials:

- > Draw your bridge and annotate it
- > Think about how you are going to make your bridge strong
- > Your bridge will need to support one of your toys i.e a teddy, lego figure, toy car etc to ensure that it is strong enough
- > It needs to be at least 15 cm tall and 30cm wide.
- > It needs to be able to battle the elements. Ask a family member to blow on it and if it falls over, then you will need to make it stronger by reinforcing parts of it or using a different material to help.
