

Tower Hill Primary School French Visit - June 2018



Recommended Packing List

For items marked with an asterix * this denotes that the item(s) is **essential**. All other items are recommended but inclusion is left to your own judgement.

Medication (where necessary) **DO NOT PACK inhalers in the case/bag which is going to be stored in the hold of the coach

- *<u>Sufficient for 5 days:</u> Underwear, socks
- *Nightclothes
- *Lightweight waterproof jacket
- *Wash kit: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, comb/brush in bag
- *2 x towels PLUS 1 small (hand) towel for the Bay Walk
- *Toilet roll usually provided but better safe than sorry!
- *Secure money container e.g. coin holder necklace/'bum bag'
- *Money (usually £ Stirling) for outward ferry crossing no more than £10.00 is recommended the children will spend what you give them!
- *Factor 50+ suntan lotion for walk across the bay of Mont St Michel (perhaps 'buddy up' so that they share with a friend)
- *Day sack/small lightweight ruck-sack to store day's purchases/'finds'
- *Paper hankies/tissues

Daywear for day of departure + 4 days away:

- ❖ 2 Sweat shirts or fleeces 1 will be the 'Tower Hill on Tour' sweatshirt that we are organising for all of the children so that they can be easily identified to travel in on the day we leave and for our visits to busy places. *Please ensure your child wears this for the day of departure: Monday 11th June.
- 4 T-shirts (1 for each day)
- *2 pairs Shorts (1 pair must NOT be below the knee football kit ones are ideal!) - essential for the Bay Walk - we get wet and muddy and will need to change before we get back on the coach!!
- Trousers/tracksuit bottoms (jeans may be worn but not those that fasten 'around their bottom' or drag on the floor!)
- Training shoes (to travel in)
- Spare pair shoes (possibly second pair training shoes)
- Cap for walk across the bay of Mont St Michel
- Clothes to change into for evening meals (4 nights)
- Bin bag for dirty washing
- Sunglasses
- Flipflops to go onto the beach in the evening

Cameras may be taken but <u>entirely at the children's own risk</u> - school will be taking photographs which will be displayed on return for families to order and purchase.
