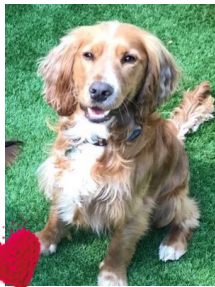
This week we were visited by the beautiful 'Archer'. Archer is a therapy dog who came to work with some of our children in school—he certainly had a calming effect on everyone.
