English 1 Lesson 1 - Comprehension. Complete the reading comprehension on Rivers of the World and answer the questions based on the text.	English/Geography 2 Lesson 2 - Research Can you complete the research pack about rivers and answer the questions. This will help you with your writing task.	English/Geography 3 Lesson 3 - Write a non-chronological report about a river around the world. These will be to teach the year 3 children all about famous rivers. Have a look at the instructions in your English Support Pack
Topic 1 - DT - Bridges Complete the Bridges Around the World pack where you will research the most famous bridges in the world and find out facts about them and how they were constructed.	Topic 2 - DT - Bridges A bridge over the Amazon River has collapsed and it is your job to make a new one. Can you build a bridge using materials such as straws, card, string, paper - anything you can get your hands on. Have a look at the bridges sheet to help you.	Topic 3 - Languages Can you learn how to say hello and goodbye in 10 different languages. Can you then teach these to a family member?

Extension:

2. Reading - can you write your own set of reading comprehension questions based on the text and ask a family member to answer them.
3. Languages - Can you learn how to say your birthday in French, German and Spanish?
