On Monday morning next week we are hosting an asthma coffee morning—please come along if you would like to find out more about how to support your child (or yourself) with coping through the winter months.

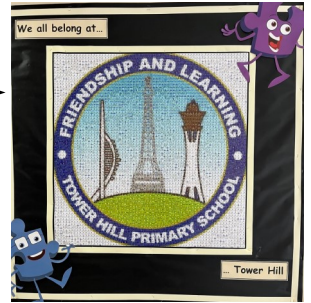
As part of Black History month, in assembly this week we learnt about a very brave woman, Rosa Parks. Her courage and resilience helped to change history!
