Congratulations to Cassie who won the Christmas card competition with the Mayor of Rushmoor. Cassie has been invited to tea and cakes in her Chamber!

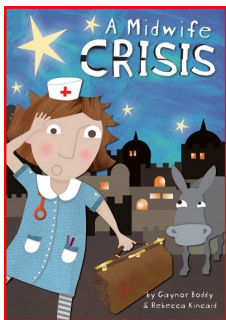

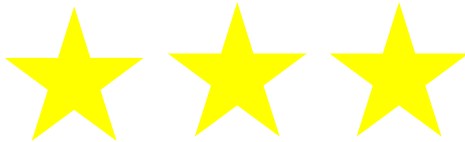




# A Midwife Crisis
