Lesson 1 - Geographical characteristics of the UK

Starter: Can you put any of these famous landmarks on the map of the UK?




- 1. London Eye

Once you have had a go, check against the internet, on a map or with an adult. Are you correct? How far away were you?

If I wanted to find these on the map, how would I know where to start?

Recap: Can you remember all of the compass points?



Learn the rhyme: Never Eat Shredded Wheat to remember the points.

Learn: What is a county?

A county is a specific region of a state or country. UK is split up to lots of different counties.

Look at map of the counties in the UK (on the last page of the pack), what county are we in?

How many coastal counties can you find on the map? (Counties around the coast of the UK).

Challenge:

Can you give directions, using the points of the compass, to the coastal counties that you have found, from Hampshire?

<u>Lesson 2 - Geographical characteristics of the UK</u>

Starter: Get someone to test you on your knowledge of the compass points. E.g. jump clockwise to north etc.

Activity: Where does the city go?

Can you plot the five cities onto the map?

Once you have had a go, check against the internet, on a map or with an adult. Are you correct? How far away were you?

Learn: Identifying rivers on a map.

Without studying it too closely: Can you tell me where the rivers are? How do you know? What do you notice about where all of the rivers are coming from?

Research rivers in the UK and find them on a map. What cities are they near? Do you know any landmarks that are nearby? What about counties that the river runs through?
